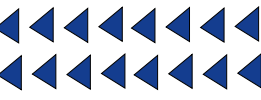

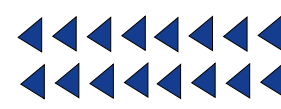

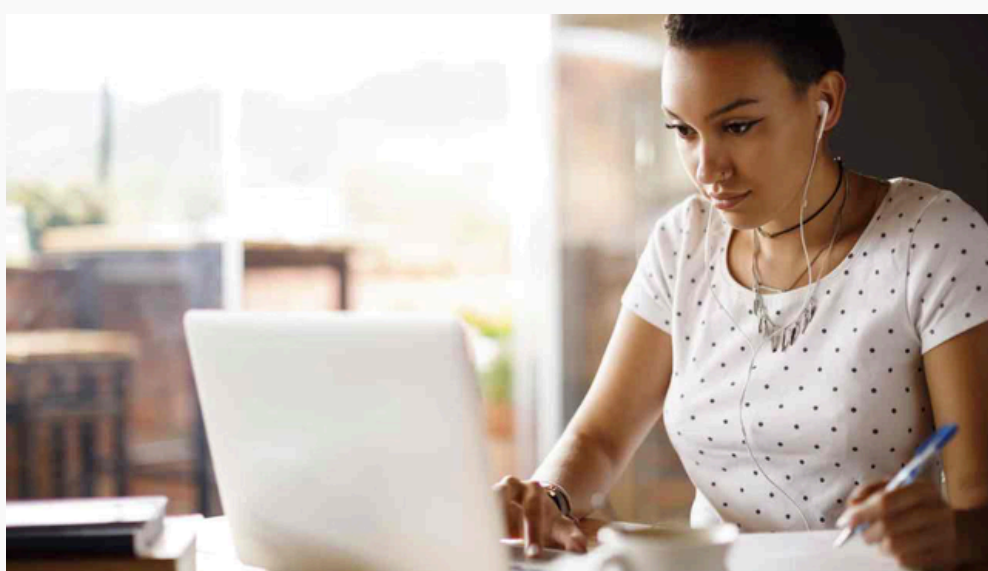
What the Accounting Academy Offers

401(k) Withdrawals for Homebuyers: Finding the Balance Between Homeownership and Retirement Security

“For many families, the decision to buy a home isn’t just financial—it’s generational. Protecting today’s opportunity while securing tomorrow’s stability is the real challenge.”



For many families in our community, this debate reflects a familiar crossroads:

Before using retirement funds, explore alternatives such as first-time homebuyer assistance programs, grants, down payment support, and strategic savings plans tailored to business owners and self-employed professionals.

Most importantly, seek guidance from qualified financial and housing professionals who can help assess both short-term goals and long-term impact. The right decision looks different for every family—but informed decisions lead to stronger outcomes.

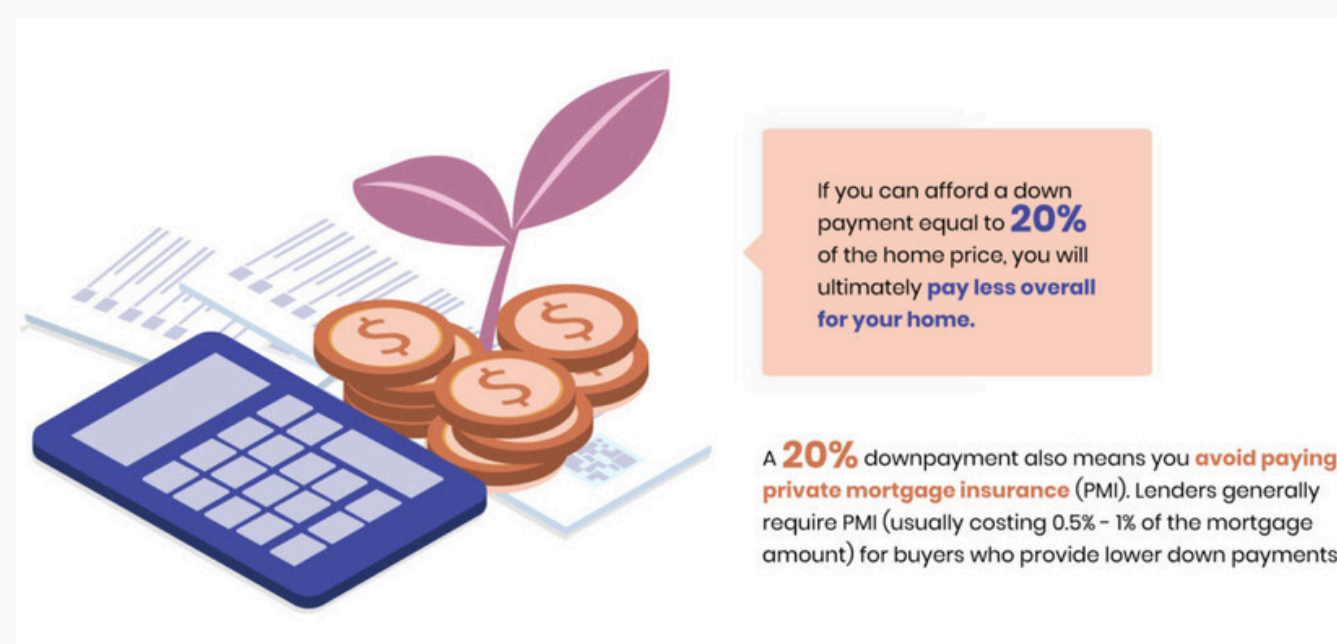
A proposed federal policy that would allow homebuyers to tap into their 401(k)-retirement savings for a down payment has sparked a national conversation—one that feels especially real for PACCA members and the Filipino-American community. With housing costs continuing to rise, the idea offers short-term relief for aspiring homeowners, but it also raises important questions about long-term financial security.

President Donald Trump recently expressed reservations about the proposal, pointing to the strong performance of retirement accounts and emphasizing the importance of protecting 401(k) savings for the future. While the housing market remains active, retirement accounts have seen significant growth, reinforcing concerns that early withdrawals could compromise financial stability later in life.

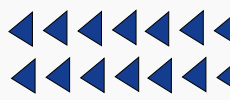


What You Can Do Now

- Pause before withdrawing: Understand the long-term impact of using retirement funds, including lost growth, taxes, and potential penalties.
- Explore first-time homebuyer programs: Look into local, state, and employer-sponsored down payment assistance and grants.
- Talk to a financial professional: A certified financial advisor can help you compare options and model long-term outcomes.
- Plan with your household or business in mind: Entrepreneurs and self-employed members should factor in variable income and business cash flow.

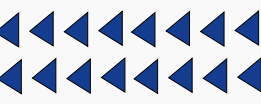

From teaching international students in the Philippines to becoming a resident educator in Brazil and ultimately establishing permanent residency while thriving as an English Language Arts teacher in the United States, Miss Princess’s story embodies resilience, purpose, and the transformative power of education.



With over 12 years of teaching experience, Miss Princess began her career in the Philippines, where she taught international students and developed a strong foundation in inclusive, learner-centered instruction. Her professional journey continued in Brazil, where she became a resident and spent five years teaching in an international school, refining her expertise in multicultural education, language development, and cross-cultural engagement. She later transitioned to the United States, where she now teaches English Language Arts in a public alternative high school serving students in Grades 11–12 who are at risk of not completing their secondary education. What makes her work especially challenging—and deeply inspiring—is her commitment to students who have often been marginalized by traditional systems. In this setting, she focuses on empowering learners through the development of critical academic skills, emotional resilience, and real-world experiences essential for responsible, independent living. She holds a Bachelor of Secondary Education major in English, has completed 30 units toward a Master’s degree in Education specializing in Literature and Language Arts, and is currently pursuing a Master of Liberal Arts in Psychology at Harvard Division of Continuing Education.

Her dedication to education has been formally recognized through multiple honors, including a 12 years’ Service Award from the **2025 UNNIFIED International Educators Summit in New York City**, an Educator of the Year Nomination at the 2025 Outstanding Filipino Awards Gala, and a Certificate of Appreciation from the Philippine-American Chamber of Commerce during the 2025 Business Luminaries Gala—each reflecting her excellence, service, and leadership in education and community engagement.

Miss Princess’s influence extends far beyond the classroom.
